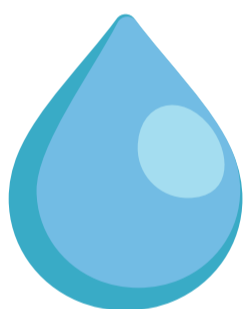


HIGH ENERGY BILLS

If your air conditioning unit has needed more recent repairs over the past few years—and those repairs are close to 25% of the cost of a new unit—it may be more cost-effective to replace it.

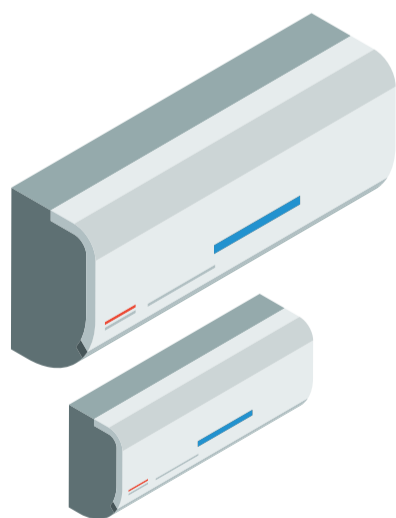


EXCESS MOISTURE AND LEAKS

YOUR AC UNIT IS OLD

The lifespan of an air conditioner can vary by the brand and model. However, most air conditioners tend to lose their efficiency after about 10 years.



IMPROPER SIZING

If your AC system is too big or small for your home's needs, it will not work properly and use more energy than it should. If your air conditioner is short cycling, meaning turning off and on too rapidly, it might be the wrong size.
